

Coastlines, ponds, parks, endless plains, forest clearings, snowy landscapes... In these isolated areas throughout the world, birds mischievously and poetically reveal their presence. Like visual stories, Pentti Sammallahti's black and white photographs attest to his extraordinary eye for detail, to light that sculpts spaces, to silent expanses in which a human or animal presence may appear at any second. The experience of the image is twofold: beyond its narrative virtuosity, the use of a two-color process, with immaculate whites (as in the plumage of the swans or pink flamingos) confronted with deep blacks, creates a play of textures and powerfully renders a world in which birds play a unique role.



Spectacular, mysterious, elegant, or grotesque, the skeletons of vertebrates that populate the Earth today carry within them the traces of evolution that span several billion years. The theory of evolution set forth by Charles Darwin in the 19th century has, for the most part, been confirmed and enriched by the discovery of genes, advances in life sciences, paleontology, and embryology. This book assesses this scientific reality. It presents a broad panorama of the realm of vertebrates, the zoological group which we ourselves belong to. This relationship becomes obvious once we observe the internal structure of animals and come to understand the mechanisms of evolution and its various aspects. Most contemporary vertebrates presented in this book come from the collections of the comparative anatomy gallery at the National Museum of Natural History in Paris.



A keen observer of the animal world and pioneer of wildlife photography, George Shiras was also the first photographer, at the turn of the 20th century, to reveal the nocturnal lives of forest animals through astonishing flash photography. From mobile shots taken from his canoe to photographic tricks he developed (when the animal itself triggers the shot by running into a tripwire), he was able to take pictures of deer, lynx, porcupines, and various birds. In an intimate format, this first-of-its-kind monograph presents a selection of these photographs, enriched with a poetic essay by philosopher and writer Jean-Christophe Bailly.





A man of letters and a companion of the surrealist movement, at a very young age Roger Caillois became interested in the mineral world, whose forms evoked imaginary figures to him. From the 1950s onwards, he started to collect minerals from all over the world, "curious stones that attract attention owing to some anomaly in their shape or some meaningful oddity in design or color." All of them have "an unexpected resemblance, one that is improbable and yet natural, which provokes fascination." This visual tour of Roger Caillois' collection is accompanied by the re-edition of his famous texts: *Stones*, *The Writing of Stones*, and *Paradoxical Agates*. Book produced in collaboration with the National Museum of Natural History of Paris (MNHN), which received a donation for a large part of the collection."

In 28 years of travels across 20 countries, Koudelka has photographed over 200 archaeological sites, using an identical panoramic format. For some of them, he returned several times in search of the "right picture." Beyond the romantic and picturesque view of these sites, Koudelka's fragmented, astonishing compositions, often just above ground level with high-angle or low-angle shots, as well as his powerfully contrasted blacks and whites, allow us to rediscover legendary places like Delphi and Pompeii. Among Koudelka's photographs, some of them show sites, such as Palmyra or Bosra, before they were damaged or destroyed during recent Middle Eastern conflicts.


