





The destruction of Carthage by the Romans in 146 BC did not prevent half-ruined houses from being rebuilt a century later, and commerce from flourishing again. Founded by the Phoenicians in 814 and razed by the Hafsîd rulers after Louis IX of France briefly conquered it in 1270, it was, undoubtedly, prodigiously wealthy, rival of Rome, capital of Africa, equal of Alexandria or Antioch. Today its vestiges, though covered by the parts of greater Tunis, still seem to reflect the aura of the ancient metropolis. The most informative and complete overview to date of this gem of our world's heritage, it embraces the legend of the city's foundation by a woman, ÉliSSa, and retraces its history until the Vandal and Byzantine periods.




