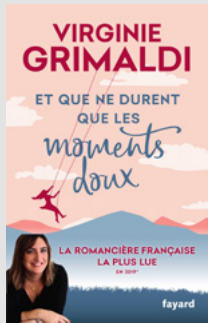

Charles IV (1316–1378) was king and Holy Roman Emperor during the Great Crisis of the Late Middle Ages (the Plague, the Hundred Years' War, the Western Schism). A member of the House of Luxembourg, he was born in Prague and raised in Paris. He would become a teenage warrior in Italy, a young king in Bohemia, an active ruler in Germany, and finally a majestic emperor. A true European who could speak, read, and write in Czech, French, German, Latin, and Italian, he was also the creator of the Golden Bull of 1356, which is still of relevance today.
