THE DISORIENTED FRENCH SOLDIERS IN THE ORIENT (1915–18)

Despite the French government's reluctance to take part in the Gallipoli campaign, more than 80,000 French soldiers were sent to the Dardanelles in 1915. Although they were apprehensive at venturing into the unknown, the soldiers were reassured by pleasant memories of reading about Ancient Greece, Constantinople, and the Orient. None of that contradiction, however, survives in their heavily censored correspondence, and contemporary press reports were silent on the subject.
