Through the voice of a woman revisiting her own past, Makenzy Orcel explores the workings of female alienation, couples, and families with great clairvoyance.

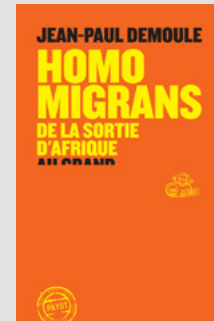

The machine that Mouchot built, nicknamed Octave, attracted Napoleon III's attention. Later, at the 1878 Universal Exhibition in Paris, it was able, among other extraordinary achievements, to produce a block of ice using solar power alone, for the first time in history. But the advent of the coal age soon brought down Mouchot's aspirations, which were deemed to be too costly. After all sorts of adventures, he made one last attempt to revive interest in his invention by "making the desert bloom" under the Algerian sun.

WHY ARE WE CAPITALISTS (DESPITE OUR BEST INTENTIONS)?

Neither brainwashing nor coercion by force, not even culture or a simple economic organization: capitalism is all of these things at once. It comes into our lives through a series of mechanisms by which economic activity is learned, legitimized, and finally (re)produced. All of these little attachments, these little enrollments, form a mesh so tight that it is difficult to get out of it. So every day we act in accordance with its principles. We often adhere fully to them, even when they go against our own convictions. We do not do so because we are made that way, we are made that way because we do so.
