Buchet Chastel

Editions Buchet/Chastel was founded in 1936 by Edmond Buchet and Jean Chastel. Edmond Buchet was a devoted talent scout who discovered many new French authors (Blaise Cendrars, Maurice Sachs) and also published established authors (André Gide, Paul Valéry, Colette). With an avant-garde spirit, he built a strong list of contemporary foreign literature (Henry Miller, Lawrence Durrell, Malcolm Lowry). From 1970 to 1994, Guy Buchet focused on developing non-literature series and launched a "Spirituality" series about yoga and Buddhist thought. The house joined the Libella Group in 2001. Since then, it has preserved and developed its focus on literature: French and foreign fiction, essays and non-fiction, and a newly developed interest in other fields, such as ecology.


