


Casterman

Founded in 1780, **Casterman** started publishing comics in 1930. Since the publication of the first Tintin comic, which is still the pride of its prestigious catalogue, Casterman has remained faithful to its initial mantra: to publish quality books for all readers. Casterman publishes comics by major authors such as Hugo Pratt, Tardi, Bilal, Peeters, and Schuiten. In addition to comic books, Casterman also publishes a wide range of children's books, from board books and pop-up books for very young readers to picture books, activity books, and works of non-fiction. We also publish literary fiction for older readers, by famous authors and illustrators such as Emile Jadoul, Anne Herbauts, François Place, or David Sala. Casterman's most famous characters include not only Tintin and Corto Maltese, but also Martine, a little girl who has delighted children around the world for over 60 years; Emilie, who celebrated her 40th birthday in 2015; and, of course, timeless characters such as Ernest and Celestine by Gabrielle Vincent.






