Denise Jacob / Miarka was 19 when she joined the Resistance movement. As a liaison agent, she collected requests for fake papers until her arrest in June 1944. She was tortured, but demonstrated extraordinary courage. She was then sent to Ravensbrück and then to Mathausen as her whole family (and her little sister, the future Simone Veil) was plunged into the darkness of the Holocaust. *Miarka* retraces the deeply moving story of a family caught up in the torments of History.
