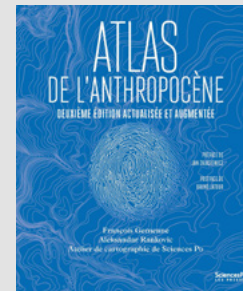


# Presses de Sciences Po
