Accessible, rich, and as inventive in its factual research as in its critical examination, this history of sexualities traces the great stages and evolutions of norms and attitudes.

A “totalizing social fact”, sexuality stands at the intersection of several kinds of historical approaches: social, anthropological, cultural, linguistic. It is impossible to speak of sexuality today without using the tools forged in studying the history of gender. More than ever, sexuality has become an essential field of history.






