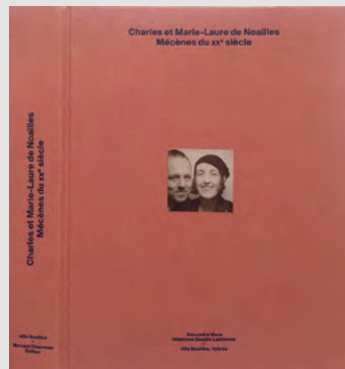

This eagerly awaited book explores the multifaceted art patronage of Charles and Marie-Laure de Noailles,

who, from 1923 to 1973, acquired and commissioned works of art in every field: visual art, cinema, music, and literature. At the risk of inciting shock or criticism, they followed, took part in, and supported the plastic and intellectual research of their time all throughout their lives.

**In 2020, for the first time in its history, humanity is bored!**

**Due to the coronavirus, people all around the world are forced to stay confined to their homes. One of the first areas in Europe affected by this deadly pandemic: the Veneto region and Venice, where Carpaccio painted boredom during the Renaissance (1490) in all of its density and strength in a work considered to be one of the "most beautiful paintings in the world."** › **Caroline de Peyster**

Who are these two Venetian women and what are they doing on this patio? With this painting, a masterpiece of the Italian Renaissance exhibited at the Correr Museum in Venice, Carpaccio is the first painter to represent boredom in an extremely coded staging. This panel, which is one of the pieces of a larger ensemble, is a real enigma. Edouard Dor reconstructs the story of this painting, attempts to decipher it, and then puts

it in perspective with other more recent representations of boredom painted by Hopper and Caillebotte.
